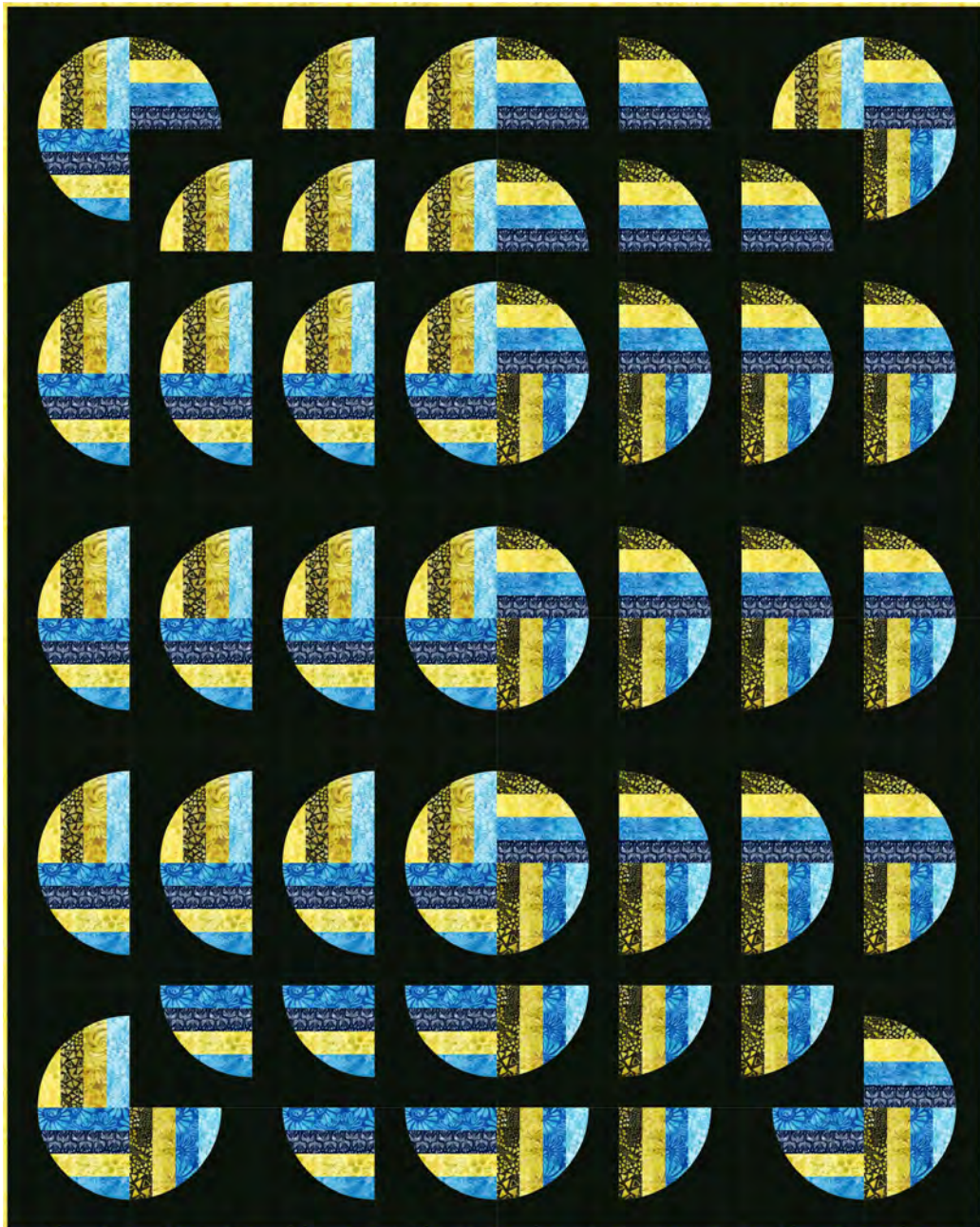

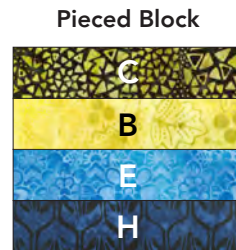
KEY	FABRIC	SKU	YD	CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS
A		100Q-1567 Jet Black	5 1/8	BLOCKS: (80) Shape 1. (Refer to template on page 6).
B		205Q-7 Banana	1-1/8	BLOCKS: (3) 6-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut (60) 2" x 6-1/2" rectangles. BINDING: (8) 2-1/4" strips. Piece strips to make continuous binding.
C		210Q-5 Mustard	3/4	BLOCKS: (3) 6-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut (60) 2" x 6-1/2" rectangles.
D		201Q-7 Blue	1/2	BLOCKS: (2) 6-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut (40) 2" x 6-1/2" rectangles.
E		202Q-8 Blue	1/2	BLOCKS: (2) 6-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut (40) 2" x 6-1/2" rectangles.
F		206Q-5 Yellow	1/2	BLOCKS: (2) 6-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut (40) 2" x 6-1/2" rectangles.
G		208Q-4 Blue	1/2	BLOCKS: (2) 6-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut (40) 2" x 6-1/2" rectangles.
H		214Q-2 Navy	1/2	BLOCKS: (2) 6-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut (40) 2" x 6-1/2" rectangles.
		Backing	5	Batting 70" x 86" piece.



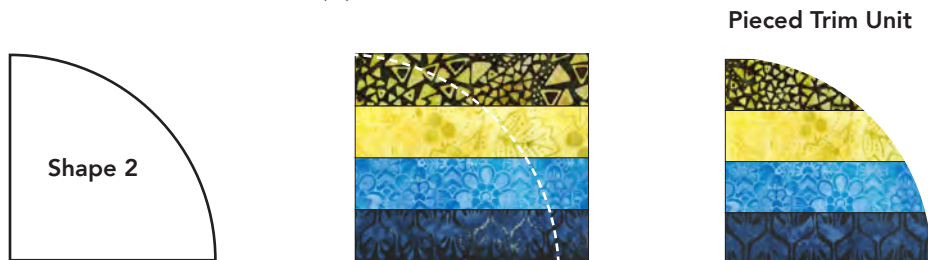

CONSTRUCTING BLOCKS:

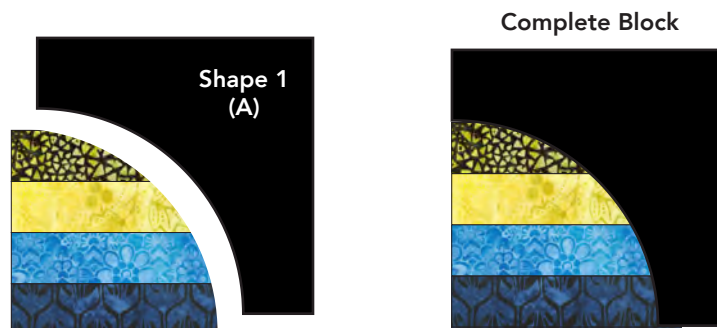
1. Arrange and sew together (4) 2" x 6-1/2" rectangles in the following order: **C-B-E-H**. Square to 6-1/2". Make (20) Pieced Blocks.



2. Use the Shape 2 template from page 7, place the template in the lower left corner of (1) Pieced Block as shown in the diagram below. Trim along the curved edge of the template including seam allowance to create (1) Pieced Trim Unit.



3. Sew (1) **A** Shape 1 to (1) Pieced Trim Unit as shown in the diagram below to complete (1) Block. Make (20) Complete Blocks.





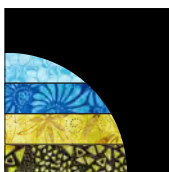

4. Using the same process as described in Steps 1-3, make a total of (80) Complete Blocks in the following fabric combinations:

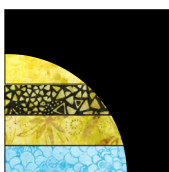
(Previously Made) **Block 1**
C-B-E-H



(20) **Block 2**
G-D-F-C



(20) **Block 3**
B-C-F-G

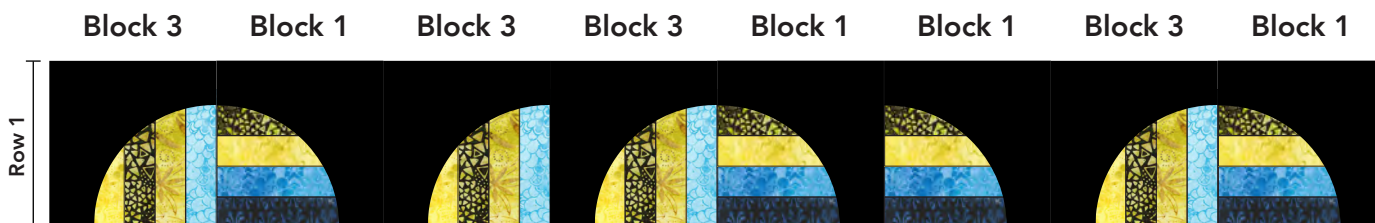


(20) **Block 4**
E-B-H-D



QUILT TOP ASSEMBLY - PIECED ROWS:

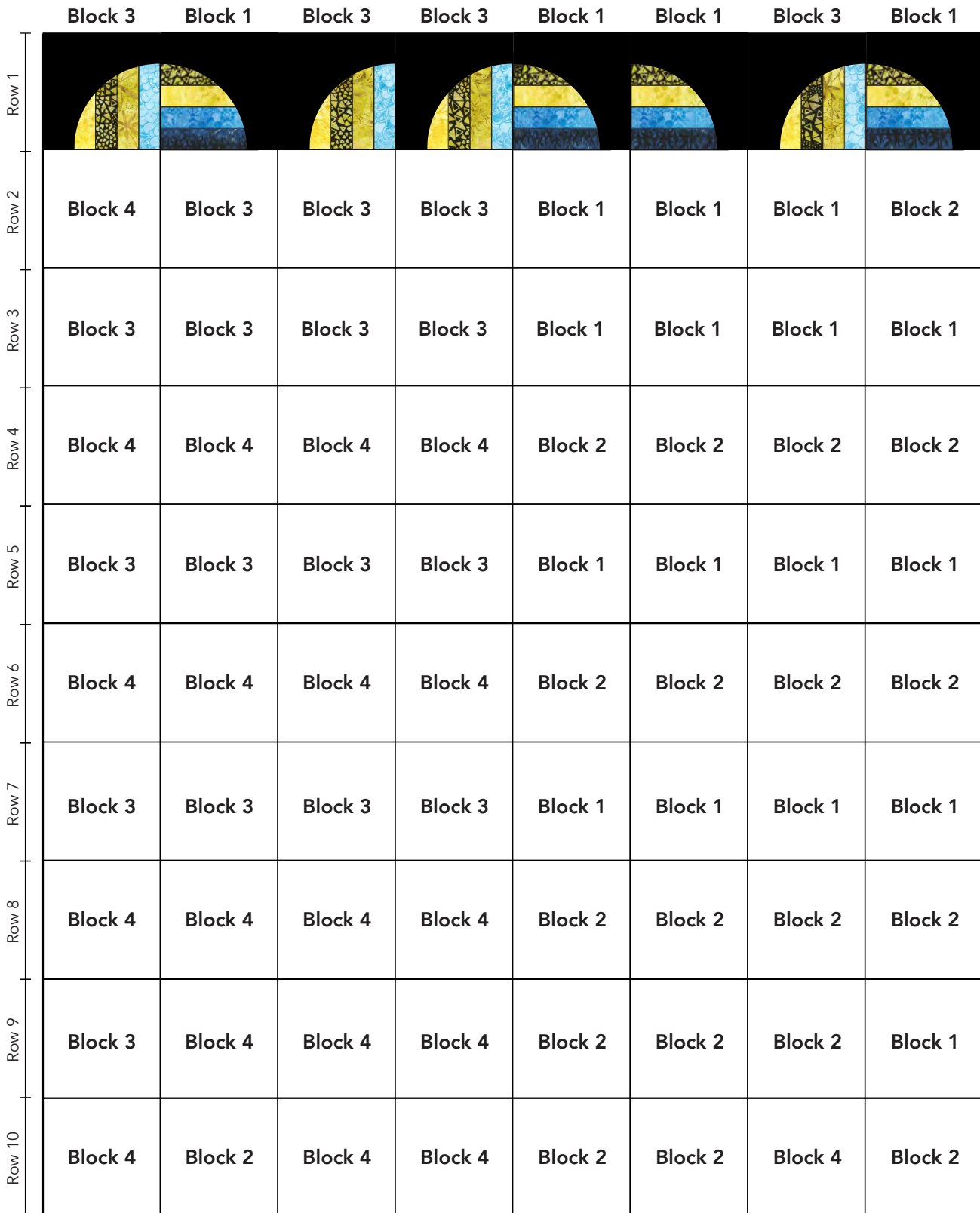
1. Refer to the Quilting Diagram on page 4, arrange and sew together (8) Blocks to make Row 1. (Note the rotation of Blocks in the Quilt on the cover page).



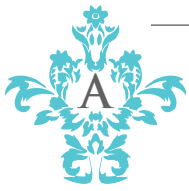
2. Using the same process as described in Step 1, complete the (10) Pieced Rows as shown in the Quilt Diagram. Then, sew all the rows together, one underneath the next, in the following order:
Row 1 - Row 2 - Row 3 - Row 4 - Row 5 - Row 6 - Row 7 - Row 8 - Row 9 - Row 10.

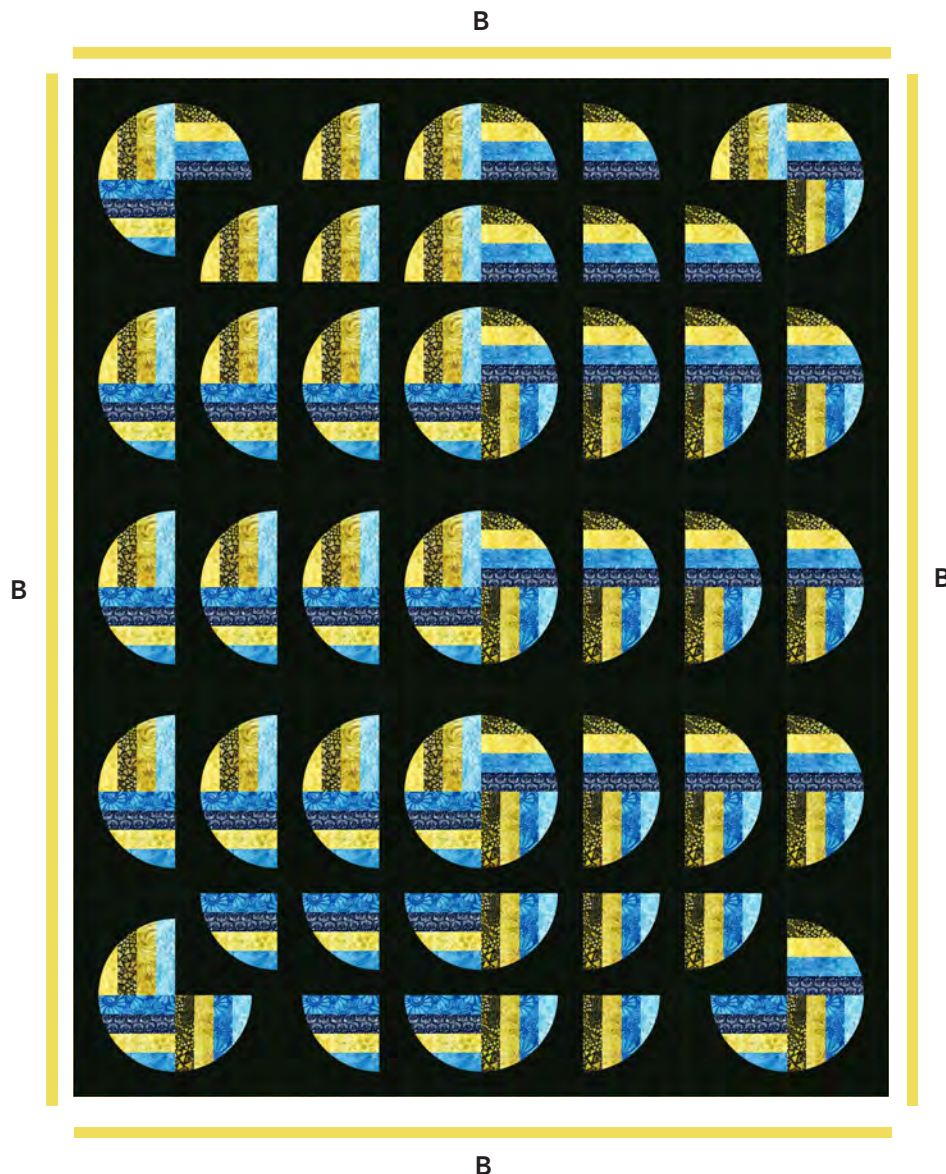
Quilt Diagram

FINISHING INSTRUCTIONS:

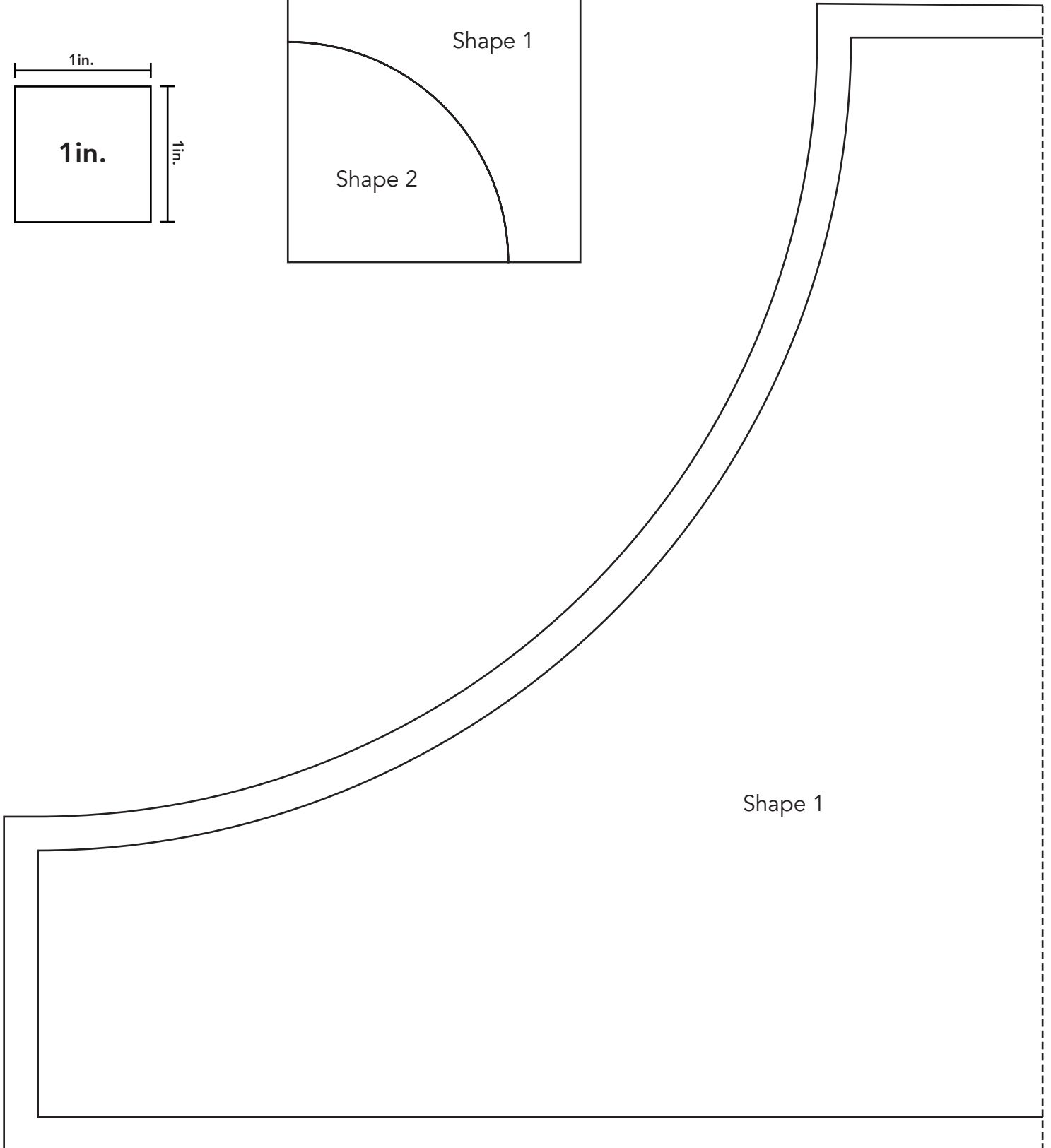
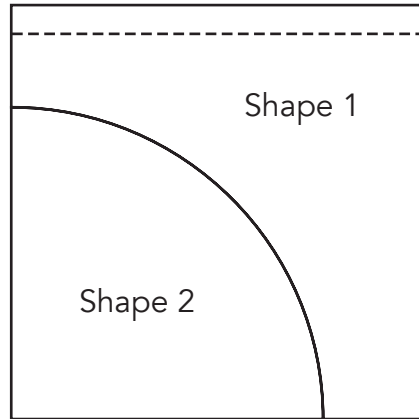
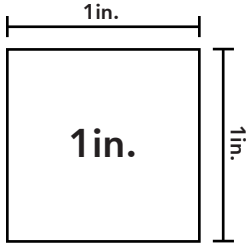
1. With the backing fabric laying taut, place batting and then quilt top to form quilt sandwich. Baste the layers together.
2. Quilt as desired.
3. Add **B** binding to finish quilt.
