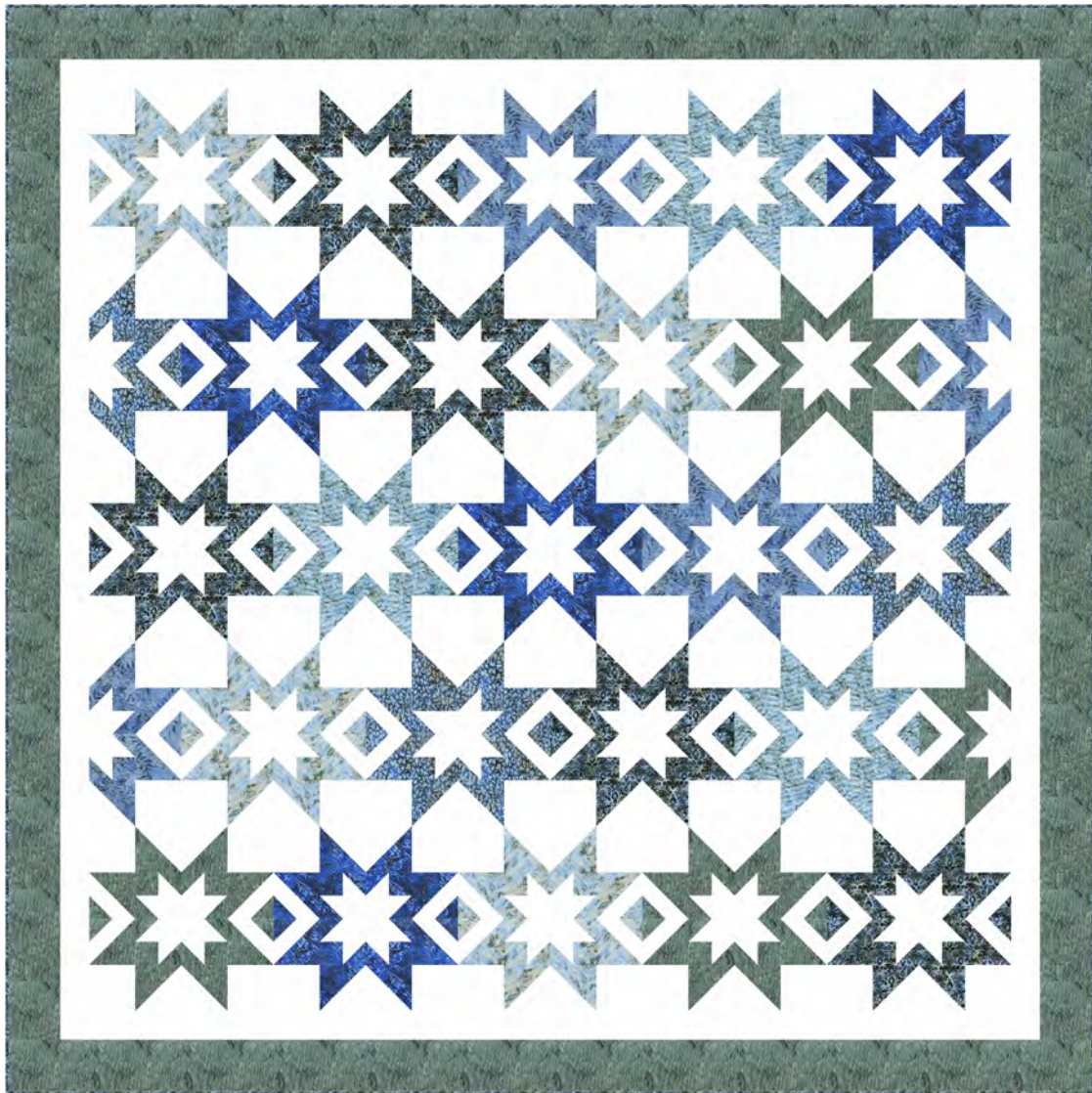



A		100Q-1540 Baby Boy	6-1/4	<p>WHOLE BLOCKS: (6) 5" x WOF strips. Subcut (46) 5" squares. (25) 4-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut (115) 4-1/2" squares and (46) 4-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles. (12) 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut (184) 2-1/2" squares</p> <p>HALF BLOCKS: (1) 5" x WOF strip. Subcut (8) 5" squares. (1) 4-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut (8) 4-1/2" squares. (2) 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut (16) 2-1/2" squares and (4) 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangles.</p> <p>INNER BORDER: (9) 3" x WOF strips. Piece strips and subcut (2) 3" x 80-1/2" strips and (2) 3" x 85-1/2" strips.</p>

Subcut (24) 2-1/2" squares.</p> <p>HALF BLOCKS: (1) 5" x WOF strip. Subcut (2) 5" squares, (1) 3" square, (2) 2-1/2" squares, and (1) 1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangle.</p> <p>OUTER BORDER: (9) 5" x WOF strips. Piece strips and subcut (2) 5" x 85-1/2" strips and (2) 5" x 94-1/2" strips.</p>

C		224Q-1 Blue Copper	1-1/8	<p>WHOLE BLOCKS: (2) 5" x WOF strips. Subcut (10) 5" squares. (4) 4-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut (20) 4-1/2" squares and (20) 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangles. (3) 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut (40) 2-1/2" squares.</p> <p>FOR BINDING: (10) 2-1/4" bias strips. Sew strips together via short ends.</p>
D		221Q-1 Blue	1	<p>WHOLE BLOCKS: (1) 5" x WOF strip. Subcut (8) 5" squares. (3) 4-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut (16) 4-1/2" squares and (16) 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangles. (2) 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut (32) 2-1/2" squares.</p>

Subcut (16) 2-1/2" squares and (8) 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangles.</p> <p>HALF BLOCKS: (1) 5" x WOF strip. Subcut (4) 5" squares and (2) 3" squares. (1) 2-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut (4) 2-1/2" squares and (2) 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangles.</p>
H		228Q-1 Blue	3/4	<p>WHOLE BLOCKS: (1) 5" x WOF strip. Subcut (4) 5" squares. (1) 4-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut (8) 4-1/2" squares. (2) 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut (16) 2-1/2" squares and (8) 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangles.</p> <p>HALF BLOCKS: (1) 5" x WOF strip. Subcut (2) 5" squares, (1) 3" square, (2) 2-1/2" squares and (1) 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangle.</p>

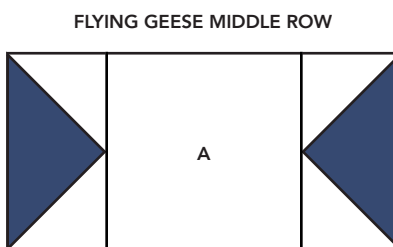
CONSTRUCTING THE STAR BLOCKS (WHOLE)

BLOCK CENTER

1. Flying geese. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) 2-1/2" **A** square. Place square, right sides together, on one end of (1) 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" **batik** rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal **A** corner triangle. Repeat with another 2-1/2" **A** square on the other end of the same **batik** rectangle to complete (1) Flying Geese Unit. Repeat to make (4) Flying Geese Units. Units should measure 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" raw edge to raw edge.



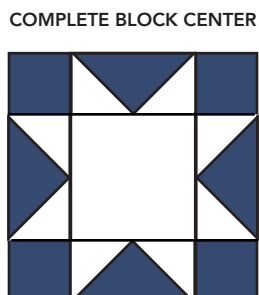
2. Sew (2) Flying Geese Units to the opposite sides of (1) 4-1/2" **A** square to make a row.

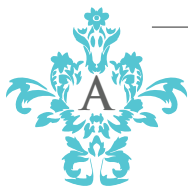


3. Sew (2) 2-1/2" **batik** squares to the ends of (1) flying geese unit to make a row. Repeat to make (2) rows.



4. Sew rows together to complete (1) Block Center. The Block Center should measure 8-1/2" x 8-1/2" raw edge to raw edge.

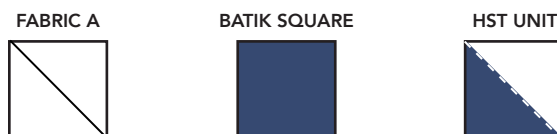

STRIPED FLYING GEESE UNITS

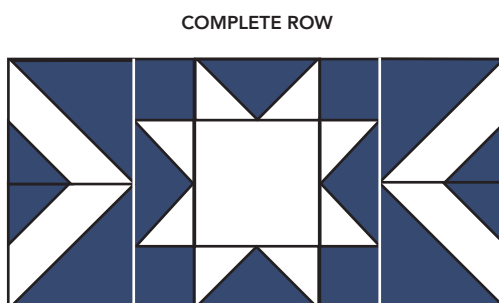
1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) 5" **A** square. Place square, right sides together, on (1) 5" **batik** square. Sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from the drawn line on both sides. Cut along drawn line. Open and press to yield (2) HST units. Aligning diagonal seam against 45-degree line of quilting ruler, trim HST units to measure $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " raw edge to raw edge.



2. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " **batik** square. Place square, right sides together, matching the corner on the white portion of previously made HST unit. Sew on drawn line. Trim $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal **batik** corner triangle. Repeat to make (4) units.



3. Join (2) units to make column, and sew to the left and right sides of block center to make a row.



LARGE FLYING GEESE UNITS

Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " **batik** square. Place square, right sides together, on one end of (1) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ " **A** rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Trim $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal **batik** corner triangle. Repeat with another $4\frac{1}{2}$ " **batik** square on the other end of the same $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ " **A** rectangle to complete (1) Large Flying Geese Unit. Repeat to make (4) Large Flying Geese Units.

CONSTRUCTING THE BLOCK

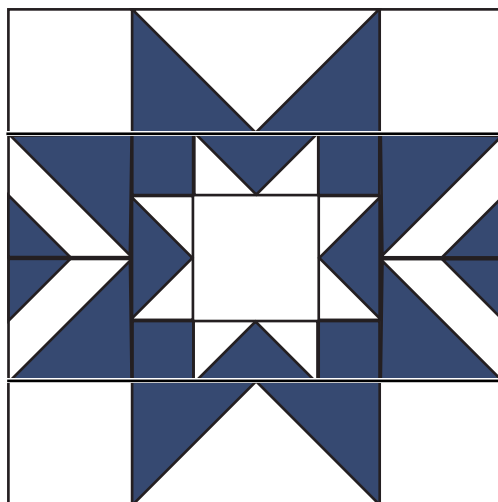
1. Sew (2) 4 1/2" **A** squares to the opposite short sides of (1) Large Flying Geese Unit to make a row. Repeat to make (2) Large Flying Geese Rows.

LARGE FLYING GEESE ROW



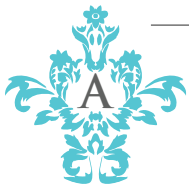
2. Sew rows made in steps 2 and 4 together to complete (1) block.

3. Make a total number of blocks in the following fabric combinations:

- (2) Block 1 **G/A**
- (2) Block 2 **H/A**
- (3) Block 3 **F/A**
- (3) Block 4 **B/A**
- (4) Block 5 **D/A**
- (4) Block 6 **E/A**
- (5) Block 7 **C/A**

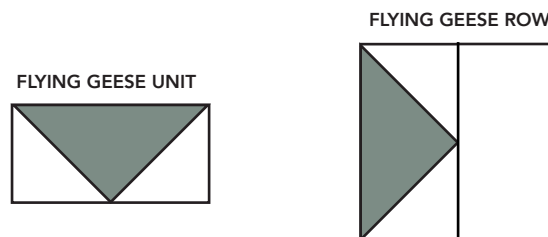
CONSTRUCTING HALF BLOCKS

BLOCK CENTER:

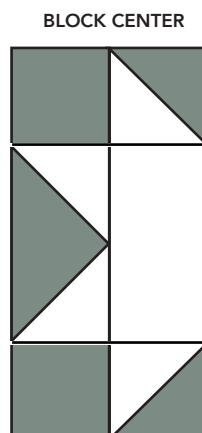
1. HST Units. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) 3" **A** square. Place square, right sides together, on (1) 3" **batik** square. Sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from the drawn line on both sides. Open and press to yield (2) HST units. Aligning diagonal seam of HST units against the 45-degree line on quilting ruler, trim HST units to measure $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " raw edge to raw edge. Join (1) HST unit and (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " **batik** square to make a row. Repeat to make (2) HST Rows.



2. Flying Geese Unit. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " **A** square. Place square, right sides together, on one end of (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " **batik** rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Trim $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal **A** corner triangle. Repeat with another $2\frac{1}{2}$ " **A** square at the other end of the same $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " **batik** rectangle to complete (1) Flying Geese Unit, measure $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " raw edge to raw edge. Join the Flying Geese Unit and (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " **A** rectangle to make (1) Flying Geese Row.



3. Join the rows made in Step 1 to complete (1) Block Center.



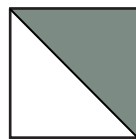

LARGE HST UNITS:

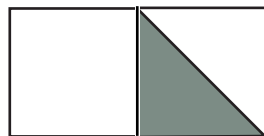
1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) 5" **A** square. Place square, right sides together, on (1) 5" **batik** square. Sew 1/4" away from the drawn line on both sides. Cut along drawn line. Open to yield (2) HST Units. Aligning diagonal seam of HST Units against the 45-degree line on quilting ruler, trim HST Units to measure 4-1/2" x 4-1/2" raw edge to raw edge. Repeat to make a total of (4) HST Units.

LARGE HST UNIT



2. Join (1) HST Unit and (1) 4-1/2" **A** square to make a row. Make a total of (2) rows, as shown.

LARGE HST ROW 2

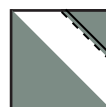


3. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) 2-1/2" **batik** square. Place square, right sides together, matching the corner of the **A** portion of (1) HST Unit. Sew on drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal **batik** corner triangle. Repeat to make (2) units, and sew together to make a column.

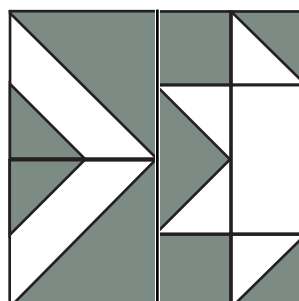

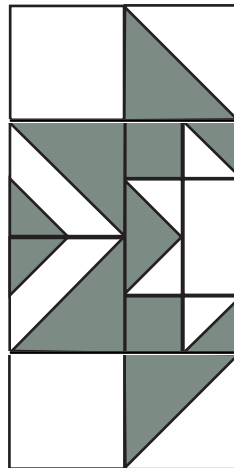


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COMPLETING THE HALF BLOCK:

1. Sew rows from Step 2 to the block center to complete (1) Half Block.

HALF BLOCK



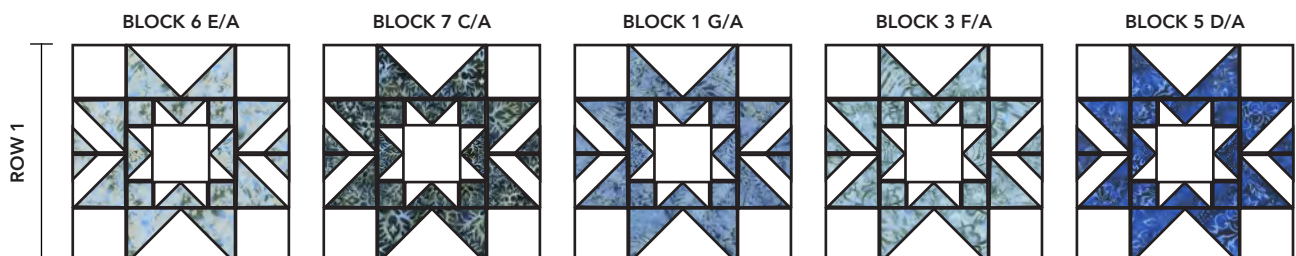
2. Make a total number of half blocks in the following fabric combinations:

- (1) Half Block 1 **B/A**
- (1) Half Block 2 **H/A**
- (2) Half Block 3 **G/A**

QUILT CENTER ASSEMBLY

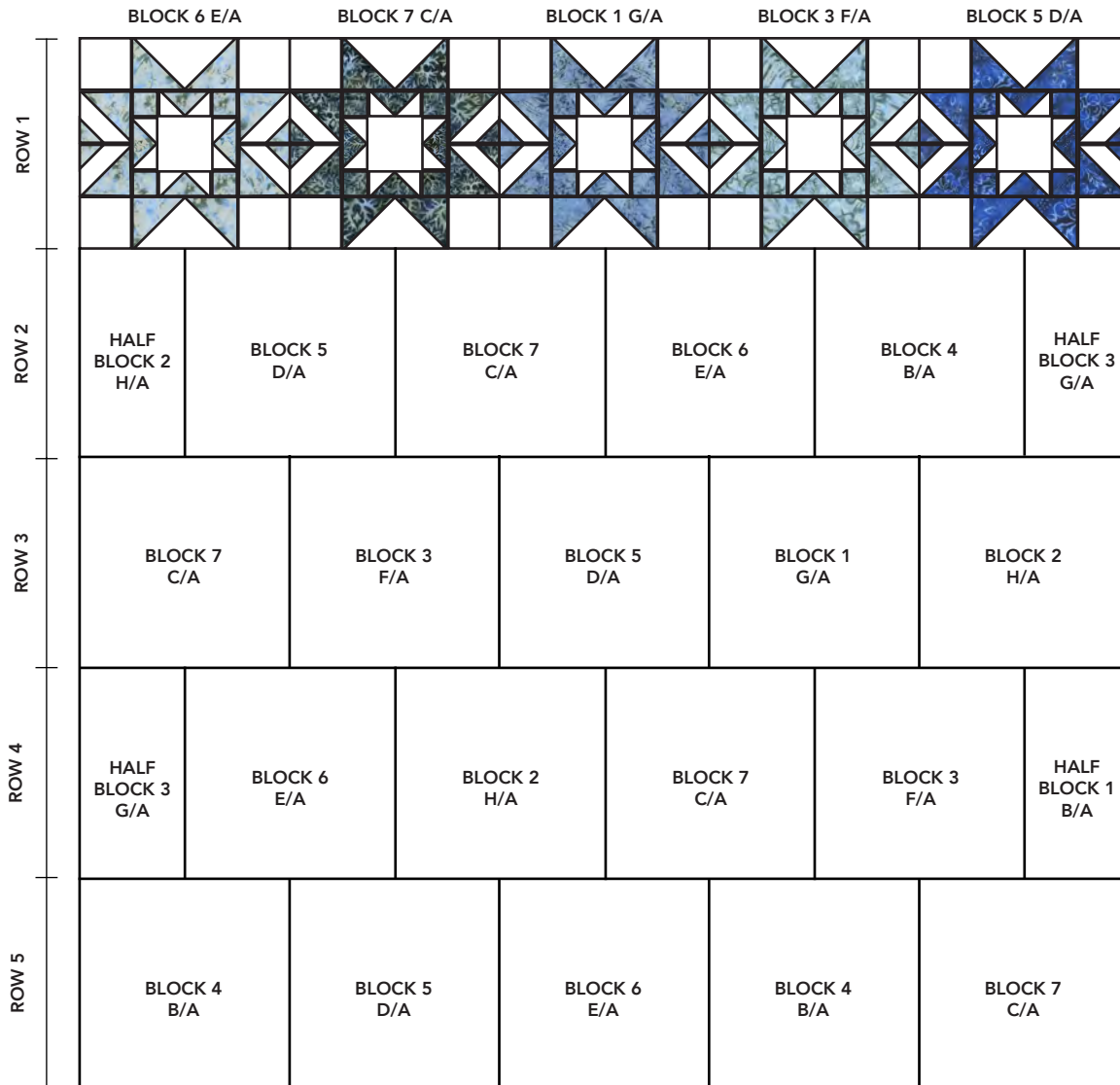
PIECED ROWS:

Arrange and sew together these (5) blocks to make the first row. Refer to the Quilt Diagram, on page 10, to create a total of (5) pieced rows. Then, sew rows together to complete quilt center.

QUILT DIAGRAM

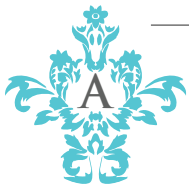
QUILT TOP ASSEMBLY

INNER BORDER

Sew (2) 3" x 80-1/2" **A** strips to the sides of quilt center, followed by (2) 3" x 85-1/2" **A** strips to the top and bottom of quilt center.

OUTER BORDER

Sew (2) 5" x 85-1/2" **B** strips to the sides of quilt center, followed by (2) 5" x 94-1/2" **B** strips to the top and bottom of quilt center to complete quilt top.

FINISHING INSTRUCTIONS:

1. With the backing fabric laying taut, place batting and then quilt top to form quilt sandwich. Baste the layers together.
2. Quilt as desired.
3. Add **C** binding to finish quilt.



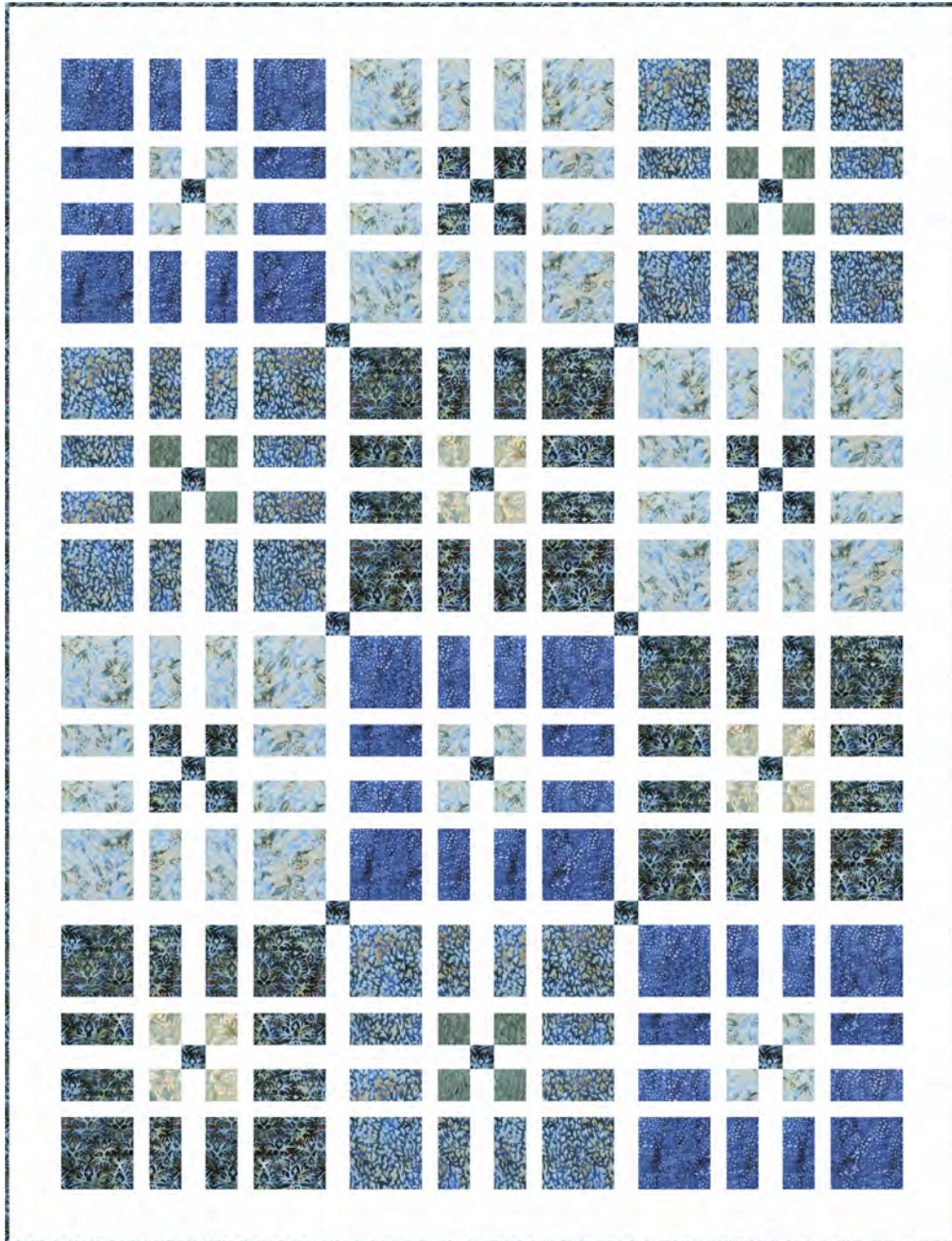
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Window Panes
