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

B		220Q-4 Beach	1	BLOCKS: (16) Shape 1 and (16) Shape 3 pieces.
C		221Q-4 Multi	1	BLOCKS: (16) Shape 1 and (16) Shape 3 pieces.
D		222Q-2 Teal	1	BLOCKS: (16) Shape 1 and (16) Shape 3 pieces.
E		223Q-2 Lagoon	1	BLOCKS: (16) Shape 1 and (16) Shape 3 pieces.
F		224Q-3 Stargaze	1	BLOCKS: (16) Shape 1 and (16) Shape 3 pieces.
G		225Q-4 Blue	1	BLOCKS: (16) Shape 1 and (16) Shape 3 pieces.
H		226Q-2 Green	1	BLOCKS: (16) Shape 1 and (16) Shape 3 pieces.
I		228Q-2 Whisper	3	OUTER BORDER: (7) 4" x WOF strips. Piece strips and subcut (2) 4" x 57-1/2" strips and (2) 4" x 70-1/2" strips. BLOCKS: (8) 2-1/4" x WOF strips. Subcut (140) 2-1/4" squares. (35) 1-1/4" x WOF strips. Subcut (140) Shape 2 pieces and (140) Shape 4 pieces.

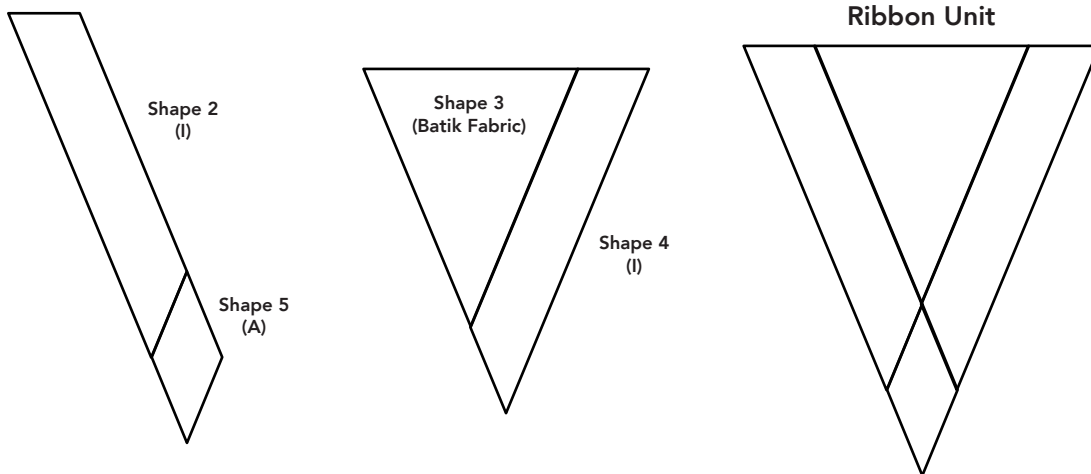


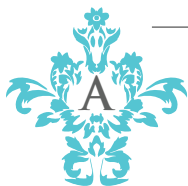
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KEY	FABRIC	SKU	YD	CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS
J		229Q-3 Stargaze	1-5/8	BLOCKS: (16) Shape 1 and (16) Shape 3 pieces. BINDING: (6) 2-1/4" bias strips. Piece strips together to make a continuous binding strip.
K		231Q-1 Teal	1	BLOCKS: (12) Shape 1 and (12) Shape 3 pieces.
		Backing	4-7/8	Batting 63" x 83" piece.

CONSTRUCTING BLOCKS

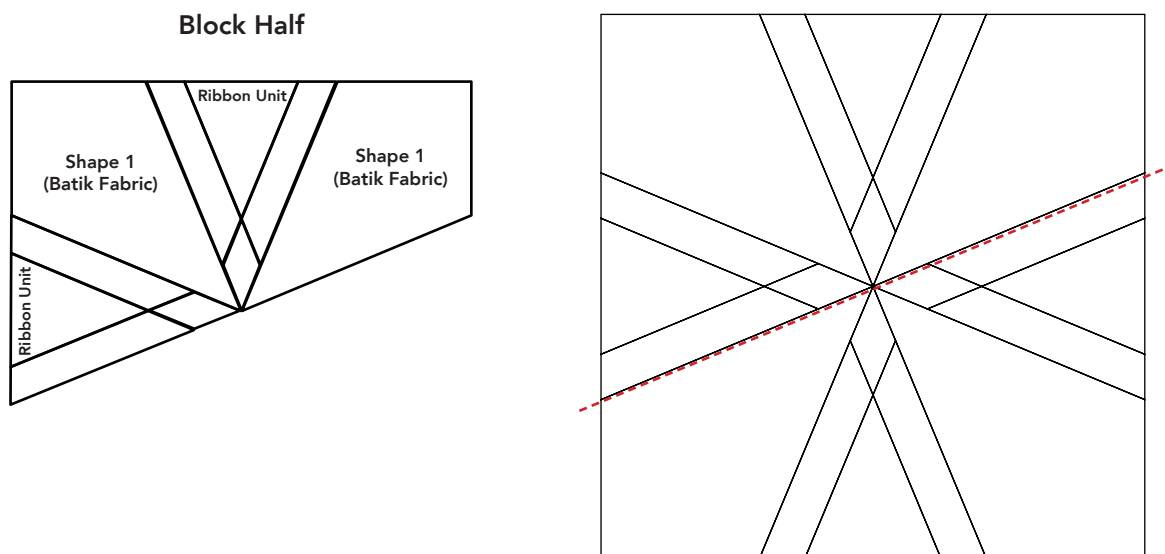
1. Ribbon Unit. Sew together (1) **I** Shape 2 and (1) **A** Shape 5 pieces to make a subunit. Sew together (1) **batik** Shape 3 and (1) **I** Shape 4 pieces to make a subunit. Sew both subunits together to create (1) Ribbon Unit. Make (4) Ribbon Units.



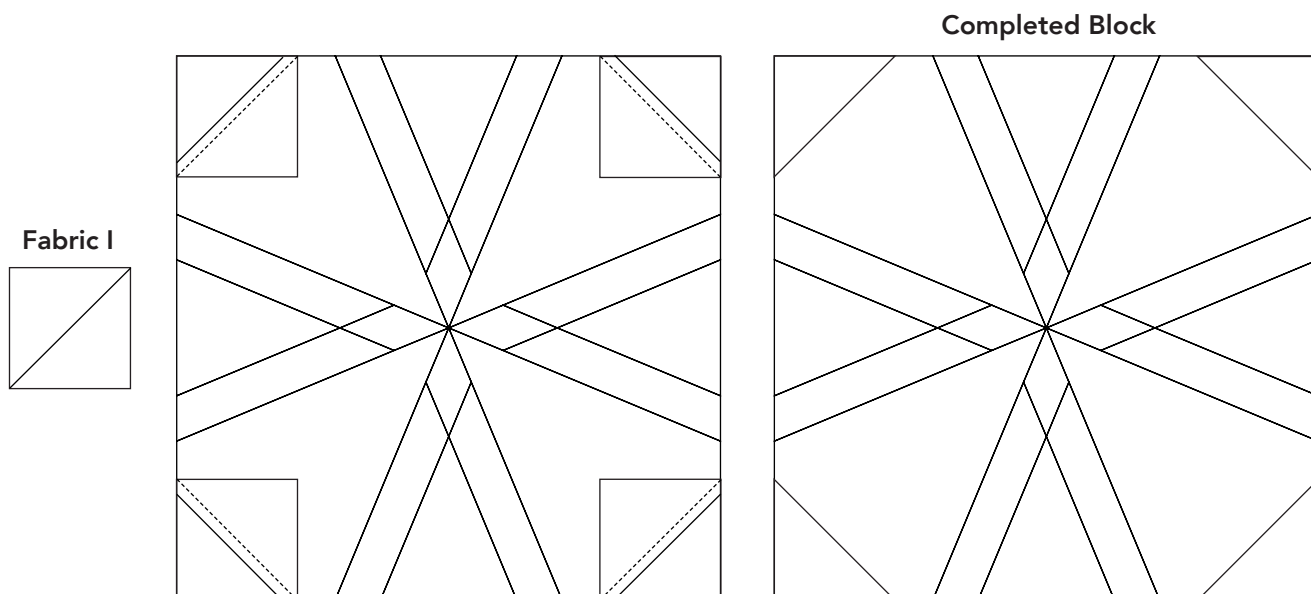


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2. Sew together (2) Ribbon Units alternating with (2) **batik** Shape 1 pieces to complete (1) Block Half, as shown below. Repeat to make (2) Block Halves, and sew halves together.



3. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) 2-1/4" I square. Place square, right sides together at a corner of sewn unit made in Step 2. Sew on drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal I corner triangle. Repeat with additional (3) 2-1/4" I squares to make (1) Block.

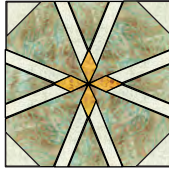




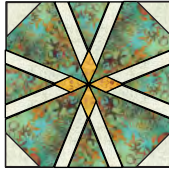
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4. Repeat Steps 1-3 to make a total (35) Blocks using the following fabric combined with **A** and **I**:

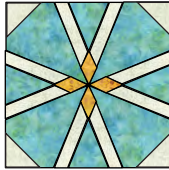
(4) **B Blocks**
(B - A - I)



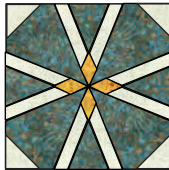
(4) **C Blocks**

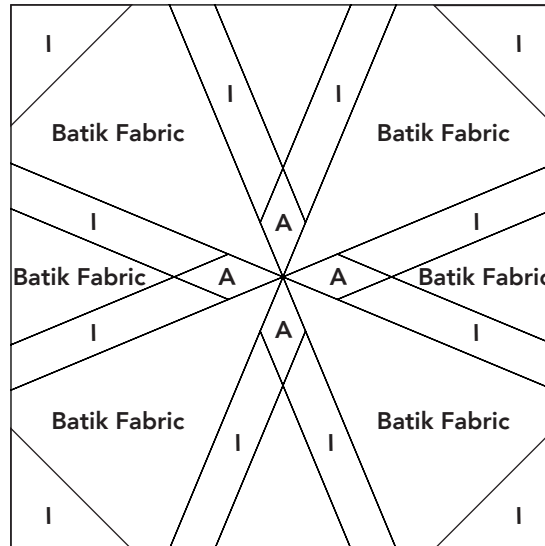

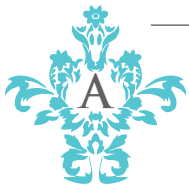

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QUILT CENTER ASSEMBLY

1. Pieced rows. Refer to the Quilt Diagram on page 6. Arrange and sew the following (5) Blocks to make a pieced row.

Row 1: **G - F - C - B - D**

Row 2: **K - B - H - E - J**

Row 3: **C - E - D - K - F**

Row 4: **J - H - F - B - E**

Row 5: **G - D - E - C - G**

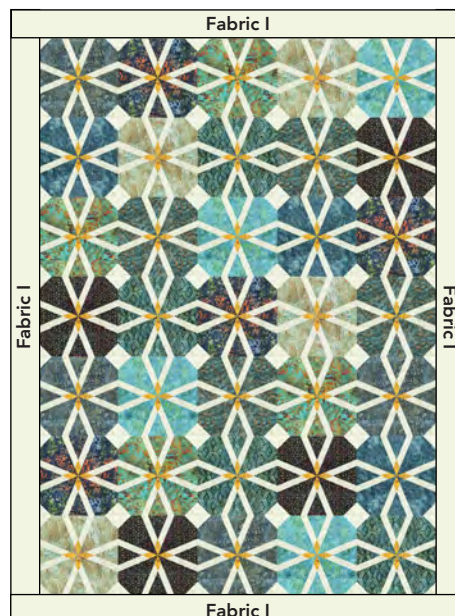
Row 6: **F - C - H - J - K**

Row 7: **B - J - G - D - H**

2. Sew pieced rows together to create quilt center.

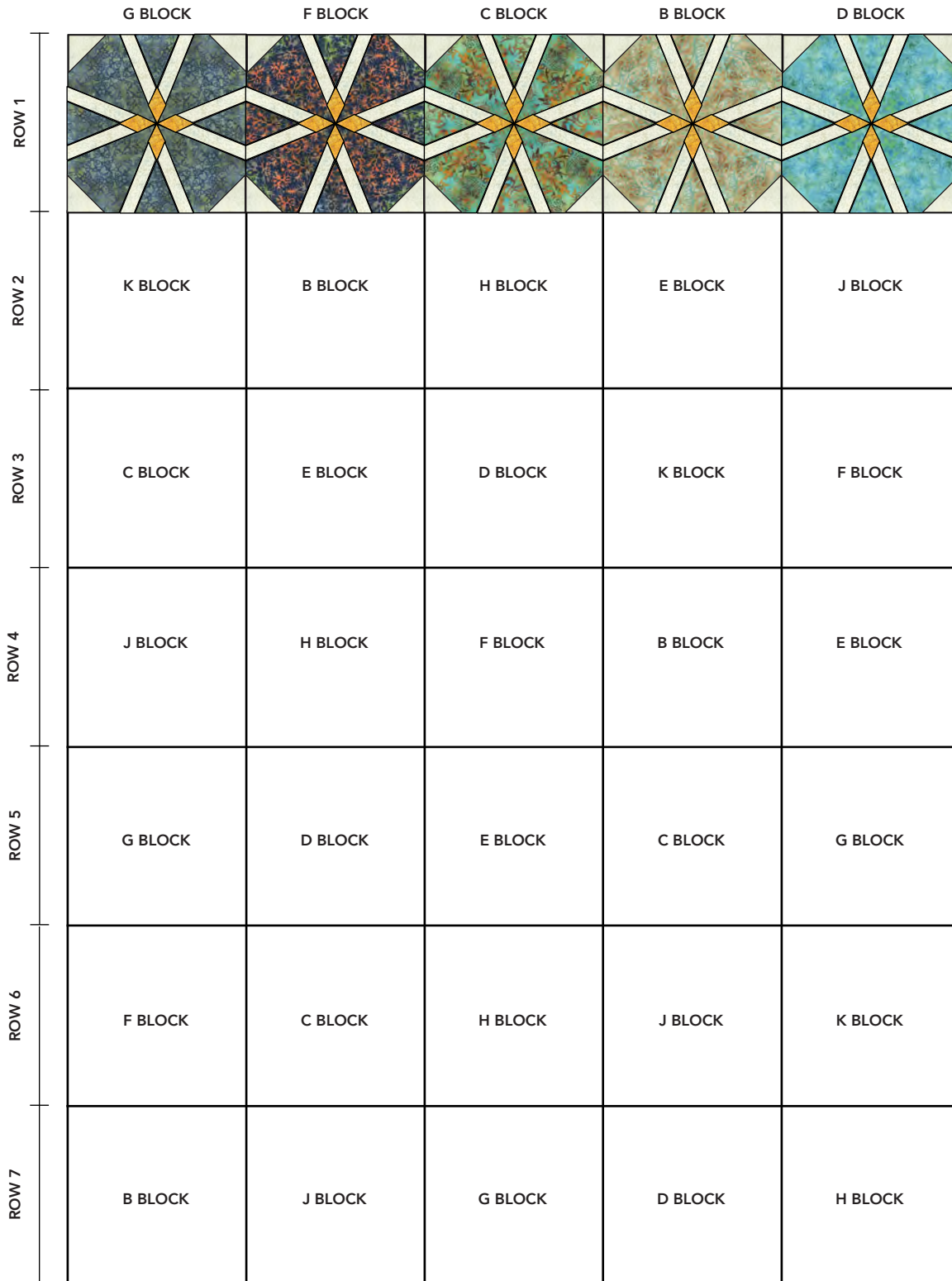
QUILT TOP ASSEMBLY - OUTER BORDER

1. Sew (2) 4" x 70-1/2" **I** strips to the sides of quilt center, followed by (2) 4" x 57-1/2" **I** strips to the top and bottom of quilt center to complete quilt top.

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4. FINISHING INSTRUCTIONS:

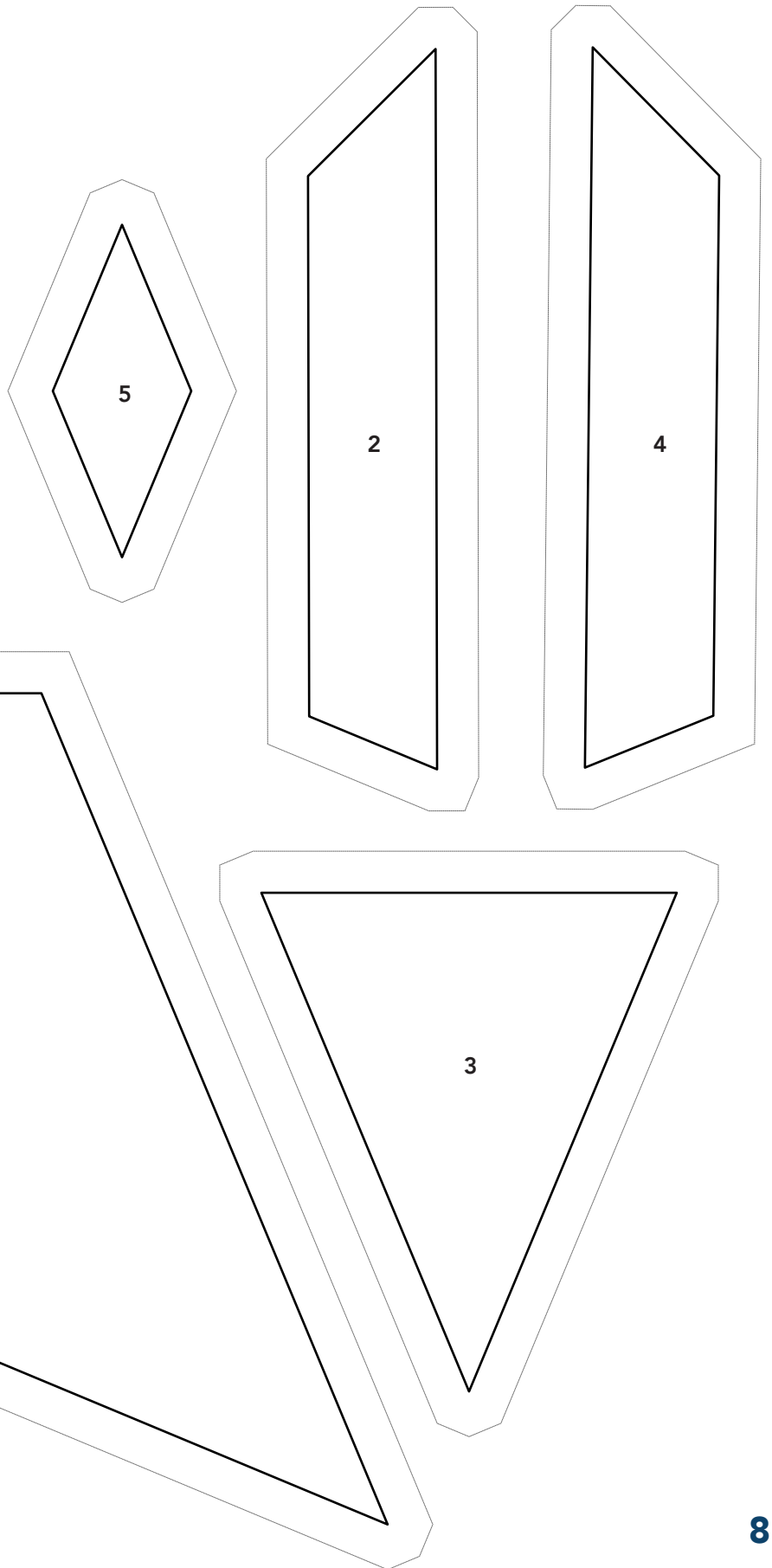
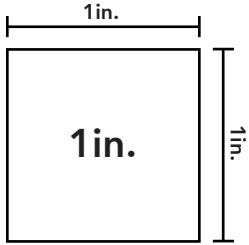
- a. With the backing fabric laying taut, place batting and then quilt top to form quilt sandwich. Baste the layers together.
- b. Quilt as desired.
- c. Add **J** binding to finish quilt.
